The Universal Care Plan (UCP) is an NHS service that allows you and your healthcare professional to co-create a digital personalised care and support plan.

THE BENEFITS OF A UNIVERSAL CARE PLAN

Having a UCP means health and care professionals across London, including A&E and the ambulance service, will be able to easily access your Sickle Cell crisis and pain care plan. This is so they can make more informed decisions about your urgent care.

HOW TO GET A UNIVERSAL CARE PLAN

You do not need to do anything. Your Sickle Cell team will transfer your care plan onto the UCP and update it with you. For more information visit our website:
